WHAT KIND OF GODS EXIST?

× Monotheism:

- + THERE IS ONLY ONE GOD WHO CREATED EVERYTHING.
- + JUDAISM, CHRISTIANITY, AND ISLAM
- + GOD => GOD

* Dualism

+ There are two gods who are fighting together. One god is good the other is evil.

Polytheism

- + THERE ARE A LOT OF GODS
- + EACH HAVE THEIR OWN DOMAIN, SPECIALTY
- + YOU WORSHIP WHO YOU LIKE/FEAR THE MOST

* Pantheism

- + THE UNIVERSE ITSELF IS GOD
- + THE UNIVERSE IS ETERNAL
- + EVERYTHING IN THE UNIVERSE IS GOD
- + ITS NEW FORM IS CALLED NATURALIST/NEW AGE MOVEMENT





CAN THERE BE MORE THEN ONE GOD?

- * We need to think about the following questions
 - + WHO CREATED ALL THESE GODS?
 - + WHAT IS THE NATURE OF THESE GODS, IS IT ALL THE SAME, IS IT DIFFERENT?
 - + WHO CREATED THE UNIVERSE?
 - × The universe is homogenous, which indicates one mind behind it.
 - x If one god created the universe, what did the other gods do?
 - + WHICH GOD CONTROLS THE WORLD?
 - + WHO DECIDES WHAT IS GOOD AND WHAT IS EVIL?
